



Kinross Primary School Contributions and Charges Pre Primary 2009



The Kinross School Council has endorsed the schedule of Contributions and Charges. The schedule is broken into four sections and will allow you to calculate all costs that you might incur throughout the school year.

SECTION 1 - Contributions

The total amount of contributions parents and carers are being asked to pay has been contained within the \$60.00 maximum set in the School Education Regulations 2000.

Money collected will be used to supplement school expenditure for classroom activities. The actual costs per child for families are shown in the table beneath. While Contributions are voluntary the quality of our teaching and learning program will be maximised when each family makes its contribution to the cost of supplementing funding gained from other sources, including the State and Commonwealth governments.

SECTION 2 - Charges for Extra Cost Optional Components

A breakdown of estimated charges for your child's participation in incursions, excursions, activities, etc. has been included in the schedule below. Detail on charges collected in previous years has informed our charges schedule. Students will only incur costs when they are involved in a particular activity. The amounts indicated on the schedule represent the maximum charged for scheduled activities. You will be asked to make payment for each activity as it approaches. (Do not pay any of this money now)

The charges schedule includes costs associated with:

specific learning activities available to <i>all</i> students, but conditional on a payment being made.	Eg incursions, excursions, classroom cooking, etc.
specific learning activities available to <i>selected</i> students, but conditional on a payment being made.	
other activities and available to all students, but conditional on a payment being made.	Eg specific classroom activities, etc.

Please note that the amounts indicated on the schedule represent the maximum that could be charged for scheduled activities and can be paid just prior to the activity.

SECTION 3 - Items for Personal Use in the Educational Program

The charge for personal use items will vary from student to student and includes:

Pupil Requirements for all students and used in lessons	eg Stationery items, etc.
Pupil Requirements recommended but not essential for all students	eg Carpet square, art shirt, tissues, etc.
Pupil Requirements for selected students and not directly part of the educational program.	eg class photograph, etc

SECTION 4 - Voluntary Approved Funds P&C Contribution

Other fundraising costs at Kinross Primary School include a P & C Contribution. These contributions have been set at \$25.00 per family. This contribution can be paid to the school office. EFTPOS facilities are available at the front counter OR Cheques can be made payable to the Kinross Primary School P&C Account.
Part of this cost is tax deductible.
