Be an Active Citizen

I will use my common sense and not access inappropriate material on the internet.

If I accidentally access something inappropriate I will

- Turn the screen away or turn it off.
- Get a teacher straight away.
- Not show others

I will not use the Internet, email, mobile phones or any other ICT equipment to be mean, rude, or unkind about other people

I will never enter any personal information (including name, address and telephone number) about other students or myself on the Internet.
