



Kinross Primary School School Parking



Parking has, and will be, a problem at Kinross Primary School for a number of years. However, with the cooperation of all concerned these problems can be reduced.

In the past we have had consultation with the Joondalup City Council, Department of Education officials and P&C representatives. As a result of these meetings several changes have occurred including the provision of Kiss & Drive facilities. It was determined that it is not feasible or cost effective to build another car park.

Parking congestion can be reduced by adopting some of the following:

- When possible walk to school, team up with other families and take turns in supervising the children to and from school.
- Car pool
- Use the Kiss and Drive facilities (Remember, no parking in this facility, so time your arrival after school for about 3.10pm to stop, pick up your children, and then drive off). If students are not ready or there are no spaces available, drive around the roundabouts and try again.
- Park safely in the areas provided. Do not park on the path or in no parking areas. If using the link roads on Kinross Drive, do not park across driveways or block residents' access. Some parents have been confronted by one of the residents on the western link road.
- Use Galloway Turn at the southern end of the oval. This area is not used by parents and has parking for 15-20 cars. It is then only a short stroll across the school oval.
- Parents of Kindy and Pre-Primary students only may use the Pre-primary car park. Congestion here can be reduced by car pooling.
- The staff car park is not to be used for dropping off / picking up students unless it is during school hours for an appointment / sick child etc.

The cooperation of all parents is requested to ensure safety for all students.
